

Updated Rental Procedures for COVID

As the impact of COVID-19 continues to manifest its self, it is essential to share with you the safety measures and operational changes we have enacted to keep campers, counselors, and employees safe.

We are working closely with Tulare Health Department officials to ensure we maintain compliance with current health and safety standards.

Pre-camp screening

Everyone traveling to Hartland must undergo a basic health screened before entering a vehicle. Anyone displaying any of the symptoms below must not travel to or attend camp.

- Check temperature. Must be below 100.3°
- Fever above 100.3° in the past 14 days?
- Any of the following symptoms in the past 14 days:

Fever, cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fatigue, muscle or body aches, loss of taste or smell, sore throat, congestion or runny nose, nausea or vomiting, diarrhea.

Cloth face masks will be required for all campers, counselors, and staff. While face masks are not required when social distancing is possible, there may be times when they are necessary.

Cleaning and Sanitation: Our employees strictly adhere to operating procedures at the highest level of compliance. Additionally, touchpoints such as door handles, restrooms, and handrails are cleaned and sanitized at an increased frequency.

Dining: Campers and counselors will be seated in cabin or “pod” groups. Tables will be spaced at least six feet apart, and social distancing will be maintained between cabin groups. Food and drinks will be served individually.

- 1) All meals are to be served outdoors. There are a number of tables located immediately outside of the dining hall.
- 2) Guests are asked to social distance whenever possible, and when not possible to wear masks.
- 3) Remind guests to hand wash often.
- 4) The Outdoor Chapel is the only available meeting space currently – while practicing social distancing.
- 5) In general, work to keep activities within cabin/housing groups and seek to keep heads at least 6 feet apart in cabins/housing.
- 6) Currently, the Climbing Wall is not available. Please check on availability on the other activities.
- 7) All guests who enter Hartland property are required to have a signed COVID Waiver form. Guests without this form may not enter the campus.
- 8) We also recommend that campers check their temperatures before breakfast each morning.
 - a. A no-touch thermometer is available in the first aid station for your first aid provider.

This situation continues to change daily, and as such, we will continue to follow the guidance provided by the CDC and the Tulare County Health Department. In addition, our goal is to do all that we can to keep campers, counselors, and employees safe – all while seeking to point them toward Jesus Christ.

WAIVER/RELEASE FOR COMMUNICABLE DISEASES INCLUDING COVID-19

ASSUMPTION OF RISK / WAIVER OF LIABILITY / INDEMNIFICATION AGREEMENT

In consideration of being allowed to use facilities for events and activities, the undersigned acknowledges, appreciates, and agrees that:

1. Attendance at events or activities includes possible exposure to and illness from infectious diseases including but not limited to MRSA, influenza, and COVID-19. While particular rules and personal discipline may reduce this risk, the risk of serious illness and death does exist; and,
2. I KNOWINGLY AND FREELY ASSUME ALL SUCH RISKS, both known and unknown, EVEN IF ARISING FROM THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE RELEASEES or others, and assume full responsibility for my attendance; and,
3. I willingly agree to comply with the stated and customary terms and conditions for attendance as regards protection against infectious diseases. If, however, I observe and any unusual or significant hazard during my presence, I will remove myself from the building and bring such to the attention of the nearest official immediately; and,
4. I, for myself and on behalf of my heirs, assigns, personal representatives and next of kin, HEREBY RELEASE AND HOLD HARMLESS Hartland Christian Camp, their officers, officials, agents, and/or employees, other attendees, sponsoring agencies, sponsors, and owners and lessors of premises used to conduct the event ("RELEASEES"), WITH RESPECT TO ANY AND ALL ILLNESS, DISABILITY, DEATH, or loss or damage to person or property, WHETHER ARISING FROM THE NEGLIGENCE OF RELEASEES OR OTHERWISE, to the fullest extent permitted by law.

I HAVE READ THIS RELEASE OF LIABILITY AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK AGREEMENT, FULLY UNDERSTAND ITS TERMS, UNDERSTAND THAT I HAVE GIVEN UP SUBSTANTIAL RIGHTS BY SIGNING IT, AND SIGN IF FREELY AND VOLUNTARILY WITHOUT ANY INDUCEMENT.
