

WHAT TO BRING

Hartland Christian Camp is located at an elevation of about 4500 feet with temperatures varying greatly. Spring and Fall afternoons are generally warm (low 70's to high 80's) and nights are cool to cold with temperatures from the 60's down to the 40's at times.

Bring:

- Bible
- Pen or pencil
- Warm clothing for the evenings
- Cooler clothing for daytime
- Good walking/hiking shoes
- "Grubbies" (clothes that can get dirty, muddy, etc.)
- Jacket, sweatshirt, etc.
- Swim Suite (modest one piece for girls)
- Towels (towels are provided in deluxe and semi-deluxe lodging)
- Sleeping bag (if you are in a cabin, Eagles Perch or Robins Nest)
- Pillow (Pillows are provided in deluxe and semi-deluxe lodging)
- Soap, shampoo, toothbrush, etc.
- Water bottle
- Camera
- Flashlight
- Lawn chair (for BBQ night or to enjoy the outdoors)
- Spending money for the Snack Bar/Gift Shop, ping pong, foosballs, and paintball.
