

Hartland Spring Quilt Retreat Project

Pat Robertson will be teaching a wool applique & embroidery wall-hanging project. For Hartland's Spring Quilt Retreat. This will be more of a "drop in if you want to learn or need help" model.

Supply list for Pat Robertson's Woolly Landscape:

Wool:

Background: Light color 17" x 21". It can be a single piece or can be pieced.

Inside border: 1/4 yard or a fat quarter

Second border: 1/4 yard (not a fat quarter)

Outside border: Checkerboard

- Light Color: 1/4 yard or fat quarter

- Dark Color: 1/3 yard - includes binding

Leaves: Several pieces or scraps of solid and tweed wool - enough for 50 leaves

Tree: Fat quarter in a darker brown

Flowers: White and red scraps (a felted cashmere sweater was used in the sample).

Pearl Cotton: Several different colors for use on the 2nd border. Green for the stems.

Additional materials: 1/2-yard interfacing with 1" squares marked 1-yard cotton fabric for the backing.

General sewing supplies, thread for applique, fray check liquid.

There is a \$5.00 charge of the pattern for this project.

There will also be a smaller project if you're looking for something easier.
